

EXPEDITION CRUISING

EXPLAINED

Expedition Cruising, first and foremost, is **an active form of holiday**- shore visits are often filled with multiple activities such as hiking, zodiac cruising, kayaking, and more. During days at sea, the clients can expect a lecture program from the resident expedition team.

Expedition cruise ships, in comparison to ocean cruise ships, **are small** - ranging from 12 passenger yachts to ships with a maximum capacity of 500 passengers, with the average expedition cruise ship in the industry accommodating around 200 passengers. The number of passengers can determine where, and how the guests can spend time ashore in certain geographical regions.

Expedition cruise voyages are often oriented towards experiencing nature, wildlife, scenery, seascapes, and landscapes. To make the most of these experiences, **the itineraries are often flexible by design** and are dictated by weather conditions, wildlife presence and regulations in certain parts of the world.



Focus on the Destination

Contrary to ocean going vessels that can sometimes be a destination in itself, expedition cruise voyages are always about the destination. Familiarise yourself with some key expedition cruise destinations to succeed in selling this type of holiday.



Expedition Team

Each expedition voyage will be led by a group of experts -an expedition leader and various topic specialists, such as historians, marine biologists, and similar. The Expedition team is the core team onboard an expedition ship - they will typically deliver lectures onboard, guide the hikes, drive the boats, and interpret natural phenomena observed.

SELLING TIPS FROM THE EXPERTS ::::::




'Get to know the destination as much as possible: check maps, read accounts, study itineraries, find out as much as possible how and why you would sell it. Ask for training – ALWAYS ask as many questions as you can! Then check the offerings: what's out there, who sells what and what makes each vessel and each company different and unique. Try to get to see the vessels, so take any opportunity to do so. Information is always key to know how to pair a client with the right company and the perfect itinerary.'

Expedition cruising is a very specialised niche. Expedition clients have researched the subject (often for years) and know their stuff. You have to know the product better than your competitors and deal with clients from a position of knowledge and experience. If you try to spoof them, they will spot it a mile away and you will lose them forever. We have become the No 1 reseller of Silversea Expeditions in Ireland and are regarded as industry leaders for Antarctica, Galapagos, Arctic etc. It has taken over a decade of learning to get us here. But we know our expeditions better than any of our competitors and we can talk to clients in a way that gains their trust.'





SELLING TIPS FROM THE EXPERTS :::::

Emma Sanger-Horwell, Kenwood Cruise:

'It's all about immersive travel. Be prepared for changes to the itinerary which makes it more exciting. Plus, don't forget there is more to expedition cruising than just the Polar Regions... Expedition cruising now covers most of the world and if someone has "done the Med to death" but doesn't want to travel too far... Offer a European Expedition Cruise. It will be quite a different experience.'

'Experience as many cruises as possible in person. Each ship and operator have a distinct personality. It's important to be able to distinguish between expedition cruise lines to get your clients on the right trip for their interests, ability and budget. Also take negative online reviews with a grain of salt. Don't rush to judgement if you read a poor review. I have found that negative reviews are often the result of a mismatch between the interests of the traveller and the style of cruise they were on. For instance, if a traveller is expecting extensive activity but books a cruise with limited options, they will be disappointed. This is another great reason to experience a wide variety of cruises and lines. '

'Expedition cruising is all about flexibility so it's essential that client expectations are managed carefully. Routes are subject to weather and sea conditions, particularly in the polar regions, as well as maximising wildlife opportunities. It's all about going with the flow and seeing what you discover along the way, not sticking to a set itinerary. A sense of adventure is essential, and the desire to learn about the natural landscapes, wildlife, history and geology of the regions you're visiting.'



SYMBOLS EXPLAINED

Expedition cruising is all about small ship adventure, and the size of the ship may determine the experience your clients will have in some destinations, such as Antarctica, Arctic, or Kimberley Coast in Australia. While some passengers may prefer travelling onboard a smaller ship with fewer amenities onboard and trips that maximise time spent ashore, larger vessels typically offer more facilities onboard and more expedition equipment such as helicopters, SUPs, kayaks, subs, etc, and there is a huge variety of mid-range ships that offer active itineraries and 3–5* amenities onboard the ships. Look out for the below icons to help you identify at a glance the typical size of the fleet operated by the expedition cruise operator member.
